PCBU Alleged Contravention 1	Not maintaining a safe work environment	Workers report that the store's air conditioning has been broken for almost two years. This issue has been verbally reported to the PCBU numerous times without action. The temperature in the kitchen was recorded at 28 degrees at 1:30 pm, with workers reporting that it increases further when cooking commences. One worker reported that they had fainted due to the heat and were aware of another worker experiencing the same issue. These incidents were not	No

		<p>reported internally, but management was aware of them.</p> <p>Controls implemented include allowing workers to sit in the cool rooms to cool down, and management has stated that they provide extra breaks when needed. Workers remain concerned about excessive heat in the kitchen during peak trade.</p>	
PCBU Alleged Contravention 2	Not maintaining safe plant and structures	<p>The PCBU was informed that weekly car checks are conducted by management. Management reported that the check engine light is faulty but stated that the car is mechanically sound. Workers avoid using the car where possible and instead opt to use their personal vehicles. The work car is not adequately maintained, with issues including ripped seats and accumulated rubbish.</p> <p>The racking is freestanding, and the team is unsure of its weight limitations.</p>	No
