Contravention	More information	Was the contravention rectified?
Not maintaining safe systems of work	There has been a change of the systems of work at the ALDI distribution centre which has caused a high number of unsafe pallets, exceeding 1.6m high to be delivered to stores.	No
Not maintaining a safe work environment	There have been several unsafe pallets delivered to site which workers have then had to unstack. On the visit conducted, there was a pallet of water stacked 1.69m high. The instruction from the PCBU is to use a step ladder to retrieve these items down. This is an unnecessary risk having to move 20kg at a time while on a ladder unnecessarily when they could be stacked at a safe level prior to being delivered to the store.	No
Inadequate monitoring of the health of workers and the conditions at the workplace	Workers have been injured due to the unsafe height of heavy items. Workers have also reported each time there is a unsafe pallet delivered. However, management on site were unsure of what	No
