PCBU Alleged Contravention 1	Not maintaining a safe work environment	Workers raised concerns with congestion in chiller. Boxes were seen to be stocked poorly and collapsing. Isles 22, 33 & 44 were congested with stock in walkways. Instead of approx. 2-meter space for walkway, approx. 1-meter available to move through. Congestion in some isles means that forklifts are weaving through pallets. While on site, near-miss was witnessed with 2 forklifts in isle 44. Could sight chiller exit door had been hit by a forklift and was being repaired while on	No

		<p>site. Workers reported this has been raised with PCBU, but no record of this reported. PCBU control to minimise congestion is having pallets for chiller moved into produce fridge and returned to chiller at the end of the day. Not effective. PCBU identified DC needs to be expanded and reported this was being worked through.</p>	
PCBU Alleged Contravention 2	Not maintaining safe systems of work	<p>Worker reported to SDA concerns with joint pain due to extended time in freezer.</p> <p>No workers in the freezer at the time of visit, had finished for the day.</p> <p>Consulted PCBU regarding the procedure for managing worker's concerns, invited Team Leader to discuss. TL stated that workers drive out of freezer to drop pallets in chiller and this is deemed a sufficient break to reduce injury concerns. No safe work procedures to manage this issue.</p>	No
