This product is being stored on the shelf without an appropriate container (polyethylene), safe handling (PPE and training) or storage (locked). As the lead sheet is unlabelled and not stored appropriately, the lead products have rubbed together forming a dust on the shelf (assumably lead). I requested the inspector's assistance for this visit to test the dust in hopes of confirming the suspicion, but this was denied as it was	No
