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**Variation to an Enforceable Undertaking between the Regulator and Ruediger  
Constructions Pty Ltd accepted on 5/08/2025**

The following variation to the Enforceable Undertaking between the Regulator and Ruediger Constructions Pty Ltd is proposed:

Under **3.4.1**

**Current:**

The Company will sponsor the Willaston Football Club (WFC) during the Barossa Light & Gawler Association's 2026 and 2027 seasons, to be called the "Industry Safety Round". This will run for 2 years (i.e., one WFC game in 2026 and another game in 2027).

Industry Safety Round guernseys will be developed and worn by WFC players during the round, from Under 13's up to the A-grade. The guernseys will include workplace safety messaging, which will have a legacy effect because they will invariably be worn by players at trainings for years to come.

The associated cost includes the cost of the themed guernseys and medals/trophies for best players.

The Company will provide the Regulator with the following (evidence) to demonstrate compliance:

1. Invoice and payment records for the marketing and livestream
2. Photographs of the Industry Safety Round/s
3. Link to the livestream
4. Copy of promotional materials promoting the Industry Safety Round (including copies of emails with club representatives)

Minimum Cost: Not less than \$65,000.00

Timeframe: 24 months from acceptance (5 August 2027)

**Replace:**

The Company will sponsor the Willaston Football Club (WFC) to hold an Industry Safety Round during the Barossa, Light and Gawler Football Association seasons in 2026 and 2027, comprising one WFC home game in the 2026 season and one WFC home game in the 2027 season.

As part of this sponsorship, the Company will provide \$60,000.00 to WFC for the purchase and installation of a permanent electronic scoreboard at Elliott Goodger Memorial Park. The scoreboard will display workplace health and safety messaging during the Industry Safety Round in both 2026 and 2027.

As a permanent installation, the scoreboard will enable workplace health and safety messages to be displayed on an ongoing basis during match days, providing repeated exposure to players, volunteers and spectators, and delivering a lasting legacy of workplace safety promotion beyond the two-year initiative.

In addition, the Company will fund \$5,000.00 for promotional activities to ensure strong community visibility of the Industry Safety Rounds.

The Company will provide the Regulator with the following (evidence) to demonstrate compliance:

1. Invoice and payment records for the purchase and installation of the electronic scoreboard
2. Photographic evidence of the safety messaging during the Industry Safety Rounds in 2026 and 2027
3. Invoice and payment records for the promotional activities
4. Copy of promotional materials promoting the Industry Safety Round (including copies of emails with club representatives)


Minimum Cost: \$65,000.00

Timeframe: Installation of permanent electronic scoreboard: To be completed and operational by 13 July 2026

Industry Safety Round 2026: To be conducted by 28 September 2026

Industry Safety Round 2027: To be conducted by 5 August 2027
