PCBU Alleged Contravention 1	Not maintaining a safe work environment	Workers report excessive stock deliveries commenced in April. Stock is being stored unsafely in the storeroom, overheads, aisle ends, on the floor in front of displays and in the site toilet. Overhead storage is reportedly above the PCBU's five box high limit and stacked to the ceiling creating risks when workers retrieve stock from height.  The quantity of stock prevents clear walkways and free movement through	No

		the store. Workers report unstable aisle end box stacks have been knocked by customers and fallen over. Emergency egress routes and a fire extinguisher are also obstructed.	
PCBU Alleged Contravention 2	Not maintaining a safe work environment	<p>Workers report excess stock to PCBU through weekly stock reports, including details of stock levels and how stock is being stored to fit within the store. Workers state these concerns have been reported weekly since early April via WorkJam, and also been raised by email, without an appropriate response from the PCBU.</p> <p>Excessive stock has increased workload and workers report excessive hours, often required to work past their rostered finish times to work through deliveries.</p>	No
