

NOTICE OF VARIATION OF A WORK HEALTH AND SAFETY UNDERTAKING

Variation to an Enforceable Undertaking between the Regulator and SRG Building (Southern) Pty Ltd, accepted on November 2019

The following variation to the Enforceable Undertaking between the Regulator and SRG Building (Southern) Pty Ltd:

MT(f) 2:

“Develop and provide the necessary course material for a national Cert III in Post tensioning”

Current: SRG will develop a monostrand Post-tensioning training package. This training package will be developed in conjunction with an accredited training provider and will be mapped to CPCCSF3002 to carry out Monostrand post-tensioning. This will include:

- Planning and preparing for post-tensioning
- Laying and fixing of anchorages and cables
- Defining the work area
- Stressing the tendon; and
- Cutting and sealing the tendon.

Tangible Outputs: SRG will develop the training materials with an accredited training provider who will validate and map to the national unit of competency. These training materials will reflect the exact nature of the work undertaken by SRG and incorporate the risk Management process learnt from Skills in Risk Management.

Replace:

SRG will develop an online and practical (assessment) training program for Post Tension Installation (PTI) employees. The online program will be based upon the existing *CPCCSF3002A Carry out Monostrand Post-Tensioning Curriculum*.

The training will be delivered via an interactive online module inclusive of images, written responses and selection based activities with stop points ensuring employees are providing responses or acknowledgements prior to moving to the next segment.

The training will be assessed via a practical assessment and competency verification, and SRG will provide certificates to workers that complete the training as well as assessment/verification of competency will be held on personnel files/internal training records.

The training package will be generic in nature and therefore upon request will be provided for use externally.
