

**NOTICE OF VARIATION OF A WORK
HEALTH AND SAFETY UNDERTAKING**
Work Health and Safety Act 2012 (SA)

Variation to an Enforceable Undertaking between the Regulator and Timco Pty Ltd accepted on 14/12/2021

The following variation to the Enforceable Undertaking between the Regulator and Timco Pty Ltd is proposed:

Under 3.2.7

Current: The Company will upgrade all safety-related labelling on all items of plant at each site, using permanent engraved metal labels in place of previously used stickers that are generally provided by the manufacturers of the plant. Following the incident, it was found that some directional labels on the press had been worn away due to regular use. The Company will conduct a risk assessment and identify the high, medium and low risks, and provide SafeWork SA with a spreadsheet containing details of plant, risk rating and timeframes. An initial trial of the labelling on a small number of machines, to determine the effectiveness, practicality and risk profile of the labels, before rolling the out the labels to all machines.

Replace: Following the incident, it was found that some directional labels on the press had been worn away due to regular use. An initial trial of the labelling on a small number of machines was conducted, to determine the effectiveness, practicality and risk profile of different kinds of labels (including metal engraved labels and laser cut laminate labels), with evidence of the risk assessment process to be provided to SafeWork SA. As a result of this process, the Company will upgrade all safety-related labelling on all items of plant at each site using engraved and/or etched Polyethylene Terephthalate labels or similar plastic labelling product in place of previously used stickers that are generally provided by the manufacturers of the plant.
