	Alleged Contravention	More information	Was the contravention rectified?
PCBU Alleged Contravention 1	Not maintaining a safe work environment	The back room of the store is being used as a storeroom, office, kitchen and staff room. The space is very small and there is excess stock which is not being managed appropriately by the PCBU. Due to excess stock, the emergency exit in the backroom is consistently blocked. The fire extinguisher is also frequently inaccessible. Worker's report raising these concerns with the PCBU with no action. Workers also report a lack of training in emergency procedures, first	No

		aid and working in isolation. Workers reported the negative workplace culture and prevalent psychosocial hazards of poor workplace interactions and inadequate reward and recognition – the cohort of workers are mostly junior staff working their first job which is not recognised and supported by the PCBU.	
PCBU Alleged Contravention 2	Unsafe use, handling and storage of plant, structures and substances	The stock in the storeroom (in a failed attempt to ensure there are adequate walkways) is stacked to the ceiling. Large items, such as computers, hang over the shelving provided. There is significant risk of objects falling onto workers when using the space.	No
PCBU Alleged Contravention 3	Inadequate facilities or access to facilities	Given the back room of the store is predominately used as a storeroom, there is lack of access to the facilities provided for workers to use during their breaks. The kitchenette is blocked by stock. Workers also report that there is a lack of airflow in store, which is posing risk of heat stress.	No
