PCBU Alleged Contravention 1	Other	The ward has 26 beds the patient in the corridor was the 27th patient. The patient, admitted following a fall with a hip injury and limited mobility, was accommodated in an alcove corridor without a call bell, oxygen, suction, or privacy screen. The nearest toilet was approximately 60 metres away Staff had to use a draw sheet to provide privacy when assisting the patient with a urinal bottle. A camera was present in the area corridor. The patient arrived from ED	Yes

		while RAT results were pending and was managed under query droplet precautions in the corridor. The RAT was subsequently confirmed negative after the patient had arrived on the ward. Primary nurse upon receiving the hand over was concerned about infection control. Staff expressed concerns regarding increased workload, extreme psychological and moral distress, professional accountability and registration, and fear of a similar incident occurring to the recent RAH event. 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Summary of matters that remain unresolved:

While this time the concern resolved with staff advocacy and ANMF intervention but practice of internal ramping continues to occur.
